Description: Built in the late 1800's, Rabbit Run was converted into a barn theater in the 1940's.

Now a historical landmark, the barn's stage has been graced by the presence of such entertainment greats as Dustin Hoffman, Jessica Tandy, Hume Cronyn, Sandy Dennis, Jim Backus, and Charles Grodin. Amidst its sylvan setting near the shores of Lake Erie, this 234-seat, fully-equipped theater produces top-notch comedies, dramas and musicals.

Location: Lake County, Ohio. Easily accessible from Interstate 90, Rabbit Run Theater is 40 miles

east of Cleveland and 50 miles west of Erie, PA.
